**Child, do not forget
the Father's mercy!**



Over the next few months the Covenant Sunday talks will focus on the reasons that we crown the MTA. At January's Covenant Sunday the theme will be Queen by right of inheritance (Queen Mother). To introduce the topic, we share the following from a talk by Father Kentenich on May 31, 1966.

"God planned and willed that spiritually Our Lord and Our Lady live indissolubly united one in the other. It can be said, therefore, that God had but one plan for the two of them. Each is made for and directed to the other to such a degree, that they are spiritually joined, so to speak. Hence, it is possible to speak of a mutual two-in-oneness between them on earth and for all eternity in heaven. Their oneness is perfect and indissoluble....

The tradition of the Church repeatedly underscores this reality. (for example) it took only a few years after the Feast of Christ the King was instituted until the Feast of the Queenship of Mary followed. Both the Savior and his mother are crowned, our Lord in his human nature.(..)

She is queen by right of inheritance because, according to the eternal plan of God Almighty, spiritually, a deep and inseparable unity between the Savior and his Blessed Mother exists... Therefore, what is due to Christ is due to Our Lady. Mary is queen. This title she inherited from Christ and the content of this title is guaranteed forever, because, from all eternity, God who is infinite and almighty planned it thus."
